## **US PILOTS LICENCES**

For the many people who hold 61.75 FAA licences (often called a "restricted FAA licence" or "piggyback licence"), which is based on their current UK licence, and still have the paper version, you are reminded that as of today (31<sup>st</sup> March 2010) your US licence is no longer valid. The only "piggyback licences" valid now are the plastic credit card style licence which also includes the "English proficient" statement. For more information a very useful summary by a Belgian pilot can be found at <u>http://www.bigginhillclub.co.uk/faa.pdf</u> - "Standalone" FAA licences are unaffected.

The CAA have apparently been empowered by the US authorities to "oversee" US registered aircraft operations in the UK (and other EEC countries authorities in theirs too). So, when flying N registered aircraft, do not be surprised to be ramp checked by a CAA inspection team (there have been several at Biggin Hill recently!), who will go through both your's and the aircraft's documentation with a fine tooth comb – you have been warned..
