Once again, any ideas would be really welcome. Lets not let the club die completely even if we lose the premises we have all come to love over the years......

I will be taking the "Chalk Board" containing all the signatures of past and present members (many of whom are no longer with us, of course) and will keep it secure for any future club's use, together with any of the important photo's and memorabilia that remain at the point of close. Once a new club opens (lets think positively!), I will loan those to the new owners, whoever they might be, for hopeful inclusion in the new premises.

JB is planning to continue to produce the Biggin Hill "Bugle" for as long as possible - items of interest will be needed regularly if JB is going to be able to do this, of course. I will take over the Pilots Pals web site from Joe and continue that, including the publication of the Bugle on there each month, and I will continue the normal monthly Database members Newsletter by email, so please keep items of interest coming. Once point, although the club premises will have closed after the end of August, your membership cards will continue to be valid for the discounts negotiated for members - the club still exists - it is just the premises that will have gone!
