Others should send a copy of their flying club membership card, a photocopy of a page of their logbook, or proof of ownership/employment at the airport. If in doubt, please phone us - details on the new club website at http://www.bigginhillclub.co.uk (Most of you are probably known to us already, but we do have to make sure, so please don't be offended if we ask!) PLEASE INCLUDE A STAMPED ADDRESSED ENVELOPE FOR THE RETURN OF YOUR MEMBERSHIP CARD, OTHERWISE THE CARD WILL BE HELD HERE FOR COLLECTION.

Once the fee is received, assuming the application is acceptable, we will issue a photo membership card (using the photo held - if you want to change this photo, please send one with your membership fee)

If you are seeking to join, but were not previously a member of the old club, please download a membership form from http://www.bigginhillclub.co.uk and complete that, sending it to us with a fee and head/shoulder photo for each person included on the form (This includes children where appropriate) - please remember to pencil the name on the reverse of each photo! If claiming "Airport" membership, please also enclose proof of airport involvement if you feel we may not already know of you ourselves. Thanks. (Please note, with the exception of non-airport people who have been Pilots Pals Club this last year, NO NEW MEMBERS WHO DO NOT HAVE AN AIRPORT ASSOCIATION WILL BE ACCEPTED!)

We look forward to receiving your membership fees in the next few weeks in time to issue your membership cards before the end of the year.
