

LONDON BIGGIN HILL AIRPORT OLYMPICS BID

WHAT THE BID IS

- It is exactly the same weekday hours as present (6:30am - 10pm)
- It lifts one-way traffic restrictions during first and last hour to allow visitors to come to London.
- It is to open at 8am instead of 9am on Saturdays & Sundays.
- It is to close at 9pm on Saturdays instead of 8pm.
- It is to close at 10pm on Sundays instead of 8pm.
- It is temporary. For a duration of 7½ weeks over the period of Olympics and Paralympics in 2012.

WHAT THE BID ISN'T

- It is NOT a request for fare paying passengers.
- It is NOT a permanent change.
- It is NOT a precedent.

HOW THE BID DIFFERS FROM THE PREVIOUS REQUEST

- 7½ weeks duration instead of 10½.
- Later opening on weekend mornings.
- Earlier closing every evening.
- Removal of fare paying passenger proposal.
